When the goal is other programs either don't require money or the scarce resource is something other than money. Those programs still have a cost. Whether it's time, political capital, or something else, measuring the cost let's us understand the true value of a program or policy. Participants in this session will explore non-financial methods for measuring that cost.</p>
